Steve Callander is Associate Professor of Political Economy at the Stanford Graduate School of Business. Previously he has held positions in the Kellogg School of Management at Northwestern University and in the Harris School of Public Policy at the University of Chicago. He received a B. Commerce from the University of New South Wales, Australia, and an MS and PhD from Caltech. His research interests are in theoretical political economy. He has worked mainly on the behavior of voters and candidates in elections as well as the design of electoral systems. His recent focus has been on the complexity of policy making, understanding how uncertainty and learning affect political outcomes in a variety of institutional settings. His research has been published in leading journals of economics and political science, including the *Journal of Politics*, the *Journal of Political Economy*, and the *Journal of Public Economics*.
