John Duggan is Professor of Political Science and Economics and director of the W. Allen Wallis Institute of Political Economy at the University of Rochester. Previously he has held positions at Caltech and at Queen's University. He is managing editor for *Social Choice and Welfare*, and advisory editor for *Games and Economic Behavior*. He received an MS and a PhD in Social Science from Caltech. His research specializations are economic theory, political economy, and social choice theory. His current work is on dynamic models of bargaining and elections, multi-dimensional spatial models of political competition, informational aspects of voting and elections, and incentives in social planning problems. His research has been published in leading journals of economics and political science, including *Econometrica*, the *Journal of Economic Theory*, the *Review of Economic Studies*, the *Quarterly Journal of Political Science*, and the *American Political Science Review*.
