JUAN RODÉS TEIXIDOR is full professor of medicine at Barcelona University. He is currently director general of Hospital Clínic in Barcelona (since 2003), with which he has maintained a long association in a number of staff positions, among them that of medical director (1984-1986) and research director (1997-2003). It was there that he founded Spain's first Liver Unit (1972), as well as the Institut d'Investigacions Biomèdiques August Pi i Sunyer, IDIBAPS (1997), which he now heads. Among his many awards is the Creu de Sant Jordi granted by the Catalan Regional Government (2001) in recognition of his research labours. Currently president of the Advisory Board of Spain's Ministry of Health and Consumer Affairs, he previously occupied this same position in the Spanish Hepatology Association (1985-1989), the European Association for the Study of the Liver (1991) and the International Association of the Study of the Liver (1992). He sits on the editorial board of a number of leading journals in his specialist area and is editor in chief of the Journal of Hepatology. He has contributed more than four hundred original articles to front-line journals and over one hundred chapters to collective publications, and is the author of some thirty books.
